

2010 Adelaide Boat Show

EXHIBITOR TERMS & CONDITIONS

The following Terms & Conditions for the Granting of Space and participation of Exhibitors are set down by the Boating Industry Association of South Australia Inc (BIASA) herein referred to as 'the Organiser', of the 2010 Adelaide Boat Show. Exhibitors are bound to abide by the Terms & Conditions

1. Submission of an Exhibitor Application Form and payment of any deposit or payment due does not guarantee space allocation.
2. The Organiser reserves the absolute right to allocate space in the best interests of the Show including the maximum, minimum and general dimensions of the space.
3. Exhibitor Applications will be accepted only after the settlement in full of any/all of the intending applicant's outstanding (every-day) BIASA accounts.
4. Displays at the Event must meet the objective of the Show and must fit within the eligibility criteria. Only new/unused products may be displayed for sale.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse an Exhibitor Application for space which in the opinion of the BIASA is not compatible with the aims, objectives and scope of the Event or for any other reason.
6. The Organiser reserves the absolute right to require a minimum standard of presentation of all exhibits.
7. Exhibition sites and structures built must be safe and not introduce hazards for attendees of the event
8. Exhibitors seeking placement in Foyer F, along the glass wall overlooking the Torrens Lake may not, without the agreement of the Organiser place temporary screens which impede full view of the Lake.
9. Exhibitors may not place temporary screens or panels, or any signage, hoarding or the like which may act, in the judgement of the Organiser, to disadvantage the visual appreciation of adjacent stands or aisle ways etc.
10. The Organiser reserves the absolute right to determine the scope of the Show and to grant sponsorship and display rights. An exhibitor may not exhibit in its display any product or service, which the Organiser in its discretion determines does not fall within the scope of the Event or for any other reason is considered unsuitable/ineligible for the Event.
11. Exhibitors shall not sub-let any part of their site to another group or organisation without the prior consent of the Organiser.
12. All components of all displays are to be moved in and out of the exhibition areas only at the times specified.
13. Construction of stands must commence prior to 5:00pm Wednesday 14 July unless other arrangements have been made with the Organiser. Exhibitor's displays are to be completed and manned (where appropriate) not less than 15 minutes before public opening times.
14. Displays must remain within the parameters of the allocated exhibitor space and must not extend into aisle-ways or walkways or onto other exhibitor's sites.
15. The Organiser reserves the right to amend or alter the exact site or size of any stand allocated should the need arise in the sole opinion of the Organiser.
16. Banners are limited to 3m in length and 1.5m in depth unless otherwise negotiated and agreed in writing by the Organiser.
17. Sites must be maintained in a tidy condition free of rubbish, hazards and spills by the stall / exhibit holder.
18. The Organiser reserves the right to inspect any exhibit at any time, and to order the removal of any part of that exhibit deemed to be objectionable or ineligible.
19. Insurance of goods and equipment and personnel is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to the extent of movement to and from the site from move in to move out and during the Event.
20. Exhibitors must hold a current public liability insurance cover (minimum cover \$10,000,000) for the Event.
21. The Organiser shall not be responsible for any damages incurred by any person or persons in the area allocated to the Exhibitor and the Exhibitor agrees to indemnify the Organiser in the event of any claim made against it.
22. The Organiser accepts no liability for damage to exhibits by loss, damage, theft, fire, storms, strikes, riots, or any other cause whatsoever.
23. No Exhibitor may conduct, permit or suffer to be conducted any lottery, raffle, guessing game, game of chance or sideshow without the written approval of BIASA. Raffles and games of chance etc which have been agreed must have been granted the necessary permits by the appropriate Government Agencies.
24. Microphones, sound equipment and machine demonstrations will be permitted only where, in the opinion of the Organiser, the level of sound causes no annoyance to neighboring Exhibitors or visiting public.
25. Exhibitors are permitted only to use the electrical contractors nominated by the Organiser.
26. Exhibitors shall at all times comply with the current regulations issued by the Metropolitan Fire Service, the Health Department, EPA, and the venue management.
27. No refunds will be made if the Event is affected by strikes, blackouts, riots or any other cause whatsoever beyond the control of the Organiser.
28. The Organiser reserves the absolute discretion to refuse admission and to exclude or eject any person from the general area of the Event whether or not that person is employed by, agents of, or associated with, any Exhibitor.
29. A deposit is due on application. Exhibitor applications will not be processed prior to the relevant deposit being paid. Cancellations of sites up to COB on the 30/06/10, at the discretion of the BIASA, may attract a fee equivalent to 50% of the total. No refunds apply after 30/06/10.
30. The signing of the Exhibitor Application Form is considered to be acceptance by an Exhibitor, or a prospective Exhibitor, of the conditions contained herein.
